



WILF, TOM & TIM LANGFORD

As Wilf Langford graduated with his Bachelor in Pharmacy degree from the University of Toronto he looked to apply his profession in the growing village of Waterdown. By 1923 - 90 years ago - he had set up shop at the corner of Main and Dundas that was soon was the hub of activity in the growing village.

The local doctor teamed with Wilf to care for the local people and provide modern medicines and preparations manufactured onsite for the first time locally. The local drugstore soon became a meeting place for all the modern conveniences and many a first date was at the Langford Pharmacy soda fountain. Living behind the store allowed people to knock on the door no matter what time of day or night if they needed something from the pharmacy. Wilf would even turn the lights back on at 11p.m. to process the bus travellers and sell tickets for those carrying on their journey.

With the advent of modern prescription drugs such as antibiotics, Wilf saw the business of preparing medicines for the people as well as the large farm animal population of Flamborough grow and truly became the 'hub of the health' of the growing community.

Living and working in the community allowed Wilf to become a pillar of the community and allowed him to champion and help in many local endeavors such as youth athletics, building local schools and supporting local causes.

As the years passed, Wilf was joined by his son Tom who graduated as a pharmacist in 1959. With a second generation to help, Langford Pharmacy continued to grow and with new people and new doctors coming to town, Waterdown had a full service pharmacy located right in the community.

Tom - as his father - worked with the healthcare partners and advanced the pharmaceutical care by providing what in those days was truly first line triage. The corner of Main and Dundas is where you went for all your healthcare needs.

Although these were much more modern times, Tom would end his day taking medicines to peoples homes on the way home from work. And he would gladly take a customers' phone call at home in the evening. As the store expanded to engulf the home behind the store where he grew up, Tom used the retail space to expand the product line past traditional medicinal remedies to carry cosmetics, greeting cards and confectionary goods to meet the needs and demands of the ever-growing town.

Finally - in 1987 - Tom - with his son Tim soon to join him from his

studies to becoming a pharmacist decided to move the ever-expanding business to the new Waterdown Shopping Center. As Tim joined Tom officially in 1989, the new Langford Pharmacy had expanded to over 7000 square feet and provided an enlarged product line and a full-service post office. Poised for the population expansion of the early 1990's, Langford Pharmacy continued to care for its customers by providing a full service pharmacy with home town values of a third generation family business.

Whether you played on the Langford Pharmacy-sponsored hockey, baseball or soccer team or won a prize from your church's annual fundraiser, the Langford family has been there for the community partnering in your health and overall wellness.

Starting in 1993 - looking to add to their great experience in Flamborough - the Langfords expanded into other communities and have owned and operated a total of nine pharmacies over the years. In 2012 the store in Waterdown was sold but currently Tim Langford owns and operates five pharmacies throughout the area and into Northern Ontario.

As a former member of the Board of Directors of the Flamborough Chamber of Commerce, Tim remarked that the selling of Langford Pharmacy in Waterdown was "bittersweet as the almost 90 years of living and working in a community and being privileged in sharing in peoples health was something that provided a great sense of pride and responsibility to his family."

The stories from the pharmacy are endless. Most are happy, and some are sad. For almost 90 years the people of Flamborough were able to walk into Langford Pharmacy and talk to Wilf, Tom, Tim or any of the Langford's staff and start to feel better.

Along the way each Langford quietly served the community out-



side work - Tom and Wilf as Rotarians and Tim as a National Advisory Board Member for independent pharmacy owners in Canada. Each have received many honours and rewards over the years.

But when asked what he thought would sum up his families legacy, this is what Tim said: "It is not the business or what we sold. It is the feeling we had when we knew our customers trusted us and we could make them feel better. If you cared enough about them sometimes they didn't need any medicine."

The Flamborough Chamber of Commerce honours and celebrates the almost 90 years of service the Langford family gave to the community and is delighted to add the names of Wilf, Tom and Tim Langford to a very special group of local business icons - the recipients of our Lifetime Achievement Award.
